INDIANA FFA INCOMPLETE CDE/LDE TEAM POLICY

This policy is FFA CDE/LDE event specific.

- 1) Teams must have 75% of members present to compete.
 - a. 75% shall be determined based on team members required as stated in event rules.
 - b. Any missing member(s) shall receive zeros (0) for event components identified as 'individual'.
 - c. Example: Events requiring 4 members, must have 3+ members present to complete all components of the event.

DOES apply to the following FFA events:

- Agricultural Business Management
- Agricultural Communications
- Agricultural Mechanics
- Agricultural Sales
- Floriculture
- Food Science and Technology
- Nursery/Landscape
- Practical Forestry
- Quiz Bowl
- Veterinary Science

DOES NOT apply to the following FFA events; event rules dictate a specific number/range of members required:

- Agricultural Education
- Agricultural Issues
- Agriculture Sales Presentation
- Chapter Meeting
- Demonstrations (All)
- Employment Skills
- Exhibit
- Leadership Ambassador
- Marketing
- Persuasive Essay
- Scrapbook (Multimedia & Traditional)
- Small Engines
- Speaking Events (Creed, Extemporaneous, and Prepared Public)
- Welding

DOES NOT apply to any 4-H/FFA events, refer to the judging committee handbook for rules on team makeup for events including the following:

- Crops Evaluation
- Dairy Evaluation
- Entomology
- Forestry
- Horse and Pony Evaluation
- Horticulture
- Livestock Evaluation
- Meats Evaluation
- Milk Quality and Products
- Poultry Evaluation
- Soils Evaluation
- Wildlife Habitat
